TRIANGLES

My triangles are made from B8 bronze round. They are hand hammered, bent to shape, and then heat treated. The hammering spreads out the overtone spectrum and makes the triangles sound fuller and more shimmering and complex. These triangles offer a warm and elegant sound at low dynamics and have a huge volume potential for the biggest moments in the orchestral repertoire.

"Heavy" models with 12 mm diameter (TBH)

These models have straight sides and a focused, piercing sound. For more variability in sound they feature an unhammered striking area that facilitates playing multiple consecutive notes with a consistent sound.

"Light" models with 10 mm diameter (TBL)

These models have curved sides and a delicate sound with shimmering overtones. The curved sides facilitate playing rolls in *pp* and offer new possibilities for striking areas.

TIMPANI MALLETS

All my timpani mallets are made with Tonkin bamboo handles with 10-11mm diameter. The shafts are carefully paired by weight, diameter, and pitch. They are then meticulously sanded and treated with a wax polish. All timpani mallets come with silicone grip tubes. The felt models are made with finest German timpani felt from Johanna Daimer, Munich.

I offer different model series with various core materials and coverings. I can also make custom mallets to meet special requests, feel free to contact me with your ideas.

Felt mallets "Ultimate Line" (UL)



Eight individually designed models, each featuring a unique combination of core construction and felt wrap, covering a wide sonic spectrum. This series offers the perfect choice for any possible application of a felt mallet, be it fast articulate passages in Mozart or Beethoven, smooth and colorful rolls in Sibelius, or grand solos in Wagner or Mahler.

Models 1-3 have a traditional design with rounded wood or cork cores. Models 4-8 feature a more modern design with a yarn wrapped "sandwich core". This technique produces a dark and warm sound that is never harsh or aggressive yet still has a clear attack.

Flannel Series (FL)



The heads of these mallets consist of stacked layers of fabric or leather, held together by a threaded nylon rod that is securely glued to the bamboo shaft. The nylon thread is much more durable and resilient than wooden threads. The upper nut can be tightened or loosened on all models to vary the number of layers or the hardness of the head.

Leather mallets with wooden core "Historic Line" (HL)

Small cores made from beech wood, covered with felt and chamois leather. Very articulate and percussive sound and shorter shafts for rhythmical playing. Well suited for baroque and early classical repertoire or fast rhythmical passages.

BASS DRUM MALLETS

My bass drum mallets feature waxed beech wood shafts with a small grip stopper at the butt end that can also be used as a secondary mallet head.

Heavy tape cores, wrapped with yarn and covered with synthetic fur. Waxed beech wood shafts, 25 mm diameter. Nylon cord for hanging from the Tamtam stand. Direct response over the entire frequency spectrum. The smallest model also makes for an ideal roller.
